- A. There Are Over Ninety Occurrences In Proverbs
 - 1. None Provide A Substantial Definition
 - 2. Considering Righteousness' Connection To Salvation We Must Broaden Our Search To The Entire Bible

 - 1. Measured By Measurements (Leviticus 19:35)
 - 2. Measured By Commandments (Deuteronomy 6:25)
