- I. PRIOR TO THE ENTRANCE OF SIN, MAN MADE IN THE IMAGE OF GOD WAS IN DIRECT, UNBROKEN COMMUNION AND FELLOWSHIP WITH HIS CREATOR
 - A. Its Uniqueness: Of All The Earthly Creatures, Man Alone Was Given The Privilege of Direct Communication From God
 - B. Its Privilege: Of All The Earthly Creatures, Man Alone Enjoyed "Immediate" Access To God
 - 1. No Intermediary Of Any Kind Was Necessary
 - 2. Vividly Depicted In Genesis 3:8
 - C. Its Application: Why Is This "Immediate" Communion No Longer In Existence?
 - 1. Perhaps A Better Question Would Be: Would Man React Positively Or Even Care If It Were Still This Way?
 - 2. We're Given Two Scenes That Demonstrate The Level Of Cooperation That Existed Between Man, God And The Rest Of Creation (2:19, 23).
 - a. It Was Instinctive
 - b. It Was Intelligent
 - c. It Was Free
 - 3. Something Has Changed Causing A Disruption To The Previous "*Immediacy*"
