 - A. The Corinthians Tried To Sever Whatever Relationship They Were In Thinking It Would Improve Their Current Status
 - B. Christians Should "Walk" For The Lord In The Midst Of Whatever Position Or Vocation In Which God Saved Them
 - C. The Pervasive Sub Theme Of "Calling" Provides The Glue That Holds The Principle Of *Staying Put* Together
 - 1. God Called You To Salvation
 - 2. There's A Sense In Which God Also Called You To Serve Him In The Situation You Were In When He Called You
- II. THIS PREVAILING GUIDING PRINCIPLE IS ILLUSTRATED BY JEWISH RITES, PARTICULARLY CIRCUMCISION (7:18-19)
- III. THIS PREVAILING GUIDING PRINCIPLE IS ILLUSTRATED BY SOCIAL STATUS, PARTICULARLY SLAVERY (7:20-24)
