I. THE LORD LAUNCHES A PROTEST WHENEVER MEN AND NATIONS EXCHANGE THE TRUE GOD FOR OTHER GODS (2:9-11a)

- A. God Would Plead His Case With Regard To This Kind Of Exchange (2:9)
- B. God Would Have Us Know That This Kind Of Exchange Is Universally Without Precedent (2:10-11)
 - 1. He Challenges People To Examine The Scenario As Far As East Is From West (2:10)
