  - 1. There Are Three References To Him In The N.T.
  - 2. Each Time He Is Always Presented As One Who Is Ignorant Of The Word Of God

  - 1. He Is Not Even A Descendant Of Aaron
  - 2. He Purchased The High Priesthood Through Flattery
