## "GOD SENT FORTH HIS SON" GALATIANS 4:5-6

## I. THERE WERE CERTAIN NECESSITIES THAT WERE PREREQUISITE TO GOD SENDING HIS SON (4:4)

- A. The Son Had To Come Forth Incarnationally
  - 1. He Could Never Have Come As The Pure Spirit That He Was
  - 2. He Could Never Have Come In A Way That Would Have Given Credence To The Gnosticism So Prevalent In The First Century
- B. The Son Had To Come As One Who Would Be In Subjection To The Law Of God
  - 1. He Could Not Have Come As A Lawless Gentile
  - 2. He Could Not Have Come As An Exempt Jew
    - a. Evidence From Infancy
    - b. Evidence From Boyhood
    - c. Evidence From Adulthood

## II. THERE WERE CERTAIN PURPOSES FOR GOD SENDING HIS SON THIS WAY (4:5)

- A. The Redemption Of Those Under The Jurisdiction Of The Law
- B. The Official Sonship Of Those Who Would Receive Christ
  - 1. Adopted Initially Via New Birth
  - 2. Adopted Finally Via The Reunion Of Soul & Spirit
