- II. THE FIRST PROPER CHRISTIAN RESPONSE TO THE LAW IS ACTUALLY TWO FOLD IN NATURE (5:1)
  - A. A Genuine Believer Will Accept The Messiah's Work As Finished
    - 1. The Nature Of Christ's Saving Work Was Liberation: "Christ Hath Made Us Free"
    - 2. This Is Just One Of Several Angles On The Nature Of Christ's Saving Work
      - a. In Relation To Satisfaction Of God's Wrath: Propitiation
      - b. In Relation To Man's Enslavement To Sin: Redemption
      - c. In Relation To The Penalty For Sin: Substitution
      - d. In Relation To Reestablishing Connection To God: Reconciliation
      - e. In Relation To The Mosaic Law: Liberation
        - i. Negatively: Not Liberty To Transgress Into Sin & Live Any Way We Want
        - ii. Positively: Liberty From Being Related To God Primarily By The Law
        - iii. Positively: Liberty From The Condemnation Of The Law
  - B. A Genuine Believer Will Act In Accordance With Messiah's Work
