KEEPING IN STEP WITH THE SPIRIT REGARDING ONE ANOTHER GALATIANS 5:25-6:1

I. THE APOSTLE GIVES AN EXHORTATION TO AVOID CERTAIN MISSTEPS THAT MAY LEAD TO RELATIONSHIP DISASTERS (5:26)

- A. Beware Of An Attitude Of Pride That Is Easily Slipped Into But Which Is Out Of Keeping With The Spirit Of God
 - 1. People Who Have This Attitude Find That It Seeps Out Despite Their Most Assiduous Efforts To Conceal It
 - 2. It Is Ultimately Manifested In Some Form Of Boastfulness
- B. Beware Of The Effects Of A Boastful Spirit On The People That You Worship With
 - 1. Some Will Take It As A Provocative Challenge To Them & Will Instinctively Express Their Own Sense Of Equality Or Even Superiority By Actively Bristling At That Attitude
 - 2. Others Will Just Simply Passively Stew In A Silent Envy

II. THE APOSTLE NOW DIRECTS OUR DEALINGS WITH THE INEVITABLE MISSTEPS OF PEOPLE (6:1)

- A. A Hypothetical Scenario Is Envisioned
 - 1. Someone Is Overtaken In Some Kind Of Wrong Doing
 - 2. The Context Suggests An Attitudinal Problem But The Broader Spectrum Of Offenses Can Also Apply
 - a. Apostles Arguing Over Kingdom Positions
 - b. Simon The Sorcerer
- B. The Spiritual Man Should Look To The Mending Of The Offender
 - 1. With A Proper Attitude Of Meekness
 - 2. With A Proper Attitude Of Self Inspection
