- I. THERE ARE TWO THINGS THAT MAKES THE OPENING STATEMENT OF PAUL'S TESTIMONY QUITE REMARKABLE (6:14a)
 - A. Consider What A "Cross" Actually Was
 - B. Consider Who The Apostle Paul Actually Was
- II. THE APOSTLE SPEAKS OF AN EVENT IN HIS LIFE THAT SO CLOSELY IDENTIFIED HIM WITH THE CRUCIFIXION OF JESUS THAT HE COULD CONSIDER HIMSELF CRUCIFIED (6:14b-15)
 - A. He Is Referencing The "World" Of Things In Which People Glory (Particularly With Reference To Salvation)
 - B. This Happens To Any Person Once They Come To Fully Realize What Christ Was Actually Doing On That Cross
 - 1. A New Creature In Christ Understands That "Circumcision" Is Nothing [No Issue Of Any Consequence] (6:15)
 - 2. A New Creature In Christ Understands That It's All Of Christ And Nothing Of Himself
