# THE SECOND TESTIMONY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST JOHN 1:29-34

#### I. CHRIST WAS INTRODUCED AS "THE LAMB OF GOD" (1:29)

- A. The Terminology That John Employed Was Not Intended To Be A Reference To Jesus' Gentle Temperament Or Meek Character
- B. The Terminology Was Employed To Capitalize On The Fact That The People's Minds Were Pre-occupied With The Subject Of The Upcoming Passover Season
  - 1. Never Before Had Anyone Ever Been Introduced As The One Who Would Permanently Deal With The Sin Question
  - 2. This Human "Lamb" Would Literally "Bare Away" The Sin Of The World

## II. CHRIST WAS INTRODUCED AS ONE WHO WAS IMMEASURABLY SUPERIOR TO JOHN THE BAPTIST (1:30)

- A. This Is Now The Third Time That The Forerunner Has Referred To Christ As One Who Was "Preferred Before Me"
- B. This Is Setting Us Up For The Ladder Sequence Of Claims To Follow In This Gospel

#### III. CHRIST WAS INTRODUCED IN KEEPING WITH WHAT GOD THE FATHER HAD REVEALED TO JOHN ABOUT HIM (1:31,33)

- A. John The Baptist Himself, Did Not Previously Know Jesus In The Terms He Is Now Presenting Him In
- B. The Reason John Did Not Previously Know Him Was Because Of The Way Christ Appeared In the Flesh

## IV. CHRIST WAS INTRODUCED IN THE CONTEXT OF HIS PREVIOUS BAPTISM BY JOHN (1:32-34)

- A. Christ Is The One Who Baptizes With The Holy Spirit (1:33)
- B. Christ "Is The Son Of God" (1:34)
