## HOW OFTEN DID CHRIST HAVE TO BE OFFERED? HEBREWS 9:25-28

## I. IT WAS NOT NECESSARY FOR CHRIST TO OFFER HIMSELF MULTIPLE TIMES (9:25)

- A. This Is An Aspect Of The Messiah's Work That Is Not Analogous To The Typology Of The O. T.
- B. Once Again, The Day Of Atonement [Yom Kippur] Is Being Used To Make The Point
  - 1. The O.T. HP Observed Blood Ceremony Every Year As Long As He Lived
  - 2. There Was No Typological Value As Far As Frequency Was Concerned

## II. HAD IT ACTUALLY BEEN NECESSARY FOR CHRIST TO OFFER HIMSELF MULTIPLE TIMES, HE WOULD HAVE HAD TO DO SO SINCE THE FOUNDATION OF THE WORLD (9:26)

- A. The Writer To The Hebrews Makes His Point By Going Back In Time To At Least The Point When Sin Entered Into The World
- B. The Reason It Could Never Have Been This Way For Messiah Is Because Repetition Implies Imperfection
  - 1. There Is No Doubt That True O.T. Saints Enjoyed A Sense Of Forgiveness Of Sin
  - 2. Nevertheless, There Is A Greatly Heightened Sense Of Forgiveness Whenever There Is Full Knowledge Of Christ's Single Act
  - 3. From Divine Viewpoint The Redemptive, Cyclical, Sacrificial Ages Came To Their Consummation With The Death Of Christ
- III. JUST LIKE MAN HAS TO DIE ONE TIME, SO DID CHRIST (9:27)
- IV. CHRIST WILL SHOW UP AGAIN, A SECOND TIME BUT THIS TIME WITH NO CONNECTION TO SIN (9:28)
