THE MESSIANIC DETERMINATION HEBREWS 10:5-10

I. THE MESSIANIC DETERMINATION WAS BASED ON THE LORD'S RECOGNITION OF CERTAIN THINGS (10:5-6)

- A. Messiah Was Aware Of Something Concerning The O. T. Sacrifices (10:5-6)
 - 1. He Makes A Totally Unexpected Comment About The Divinely Ordained Sacrificial System (10:5a & 6)
 - Messiah Recognized What The Average Israelite Was Completely Unaware Of: What Was Going On In The Heart Of God
 - b. He Uses Two Words To Just Sweep The Whole Thing Away: "Sacrifice & Offering"
 - 2. He Takes Animal Sacrifice & Vegetable Offering & Puts Them In The Two Categories Of Voluntary & Mandatory & Concludes It Ultimately Didn't Matter (10:6)
- B. Messiah Was Aware Of Something Concerning Himself: "A Body Hast Thou Prepared Me" (10:5b)
 - 1. The Writer To The Hebrews Captured The Essence Of The Psalmist's "Mine Ears Hast Thou Opened" In Psalm 40:6
 - 2. The Idea Is More Fully Developed In John 6

II. THE MESSIANIC DETERMINATION WAS SUPPORTED BY A STATEMENT OF UNFATHOMABLE SUBMISSION (10:7)

- A. Psalm 40:8 Adds That It Was His "Delight"
- B. He Did Willingly What Anyone Else, Would Have, At Best, Done Grudgingly

III. THE MESSIANIC DETERMINATION WAS THE SURE REPLACEMENT OF THAT FIRST SYSTEM OF OFFERINGS (10:8-10)

- A. "He Taketh Away" Drips With Blood (10:9)
- B. He Proffered For Believers A Complete Sanctification (10:10)
