- A. Note The Difference In What Follows the Word "Born" In The Third And Fifth Verses
- B. Note The Necessary Elements Of This Second Birth As Being "Water" And "Spirit" (The Latter Of Which Is Expanded Upon)
 - 1. Though Nicodemus Was A "Master Of Israel" He Missed The O.T. Connection Between Water's Symbolic Cleansing Properties And The Spirit Of God Enabling Men To Walk In The Lord's Statutes (Ezekiel 36:25-27)
 - 2. Though Nicodemus Was A "Master Of Israel" He Could Not Have Understood The Telescopic Effects Of The New Covenant
- C. Note How The N.T. Provides A Clarifying Theology On The Metaphorical Use Of "Water"
 - 1. The O.T. Requirement That A Man Be "Clean" Is Accomplished In The N.T. Through The "Word" (John 15:3; Ephesians 5:26)
 - 2. The Lord's Half Brother, James And The Apostle Peter Make The Connection Between The Giving Of Birth And The Word (James 1:18; I Peter 1:23)
