- I. OUR MAJOR NEED IS SUMMARIZED IN ONE TERM: WISDOM (1:5)
  - A. Wisdom Is Much More Than The Accumulation Of Facts Or The Reception Of Knowledge
  - B. Wisdom Has To Do With The Way We Harness Up The Facts And Make Them Work
    - 1. The Facts Are Universal
    - 2. The Thing That Makes A Trial So Difficult For Us Is That We Do Not Know What To Do
- II. WE ARE COMMANDED TO GO TO THE LORD AND REQUEST FROM HIM A SUPERNATURAL UNDERSTANDING, INSIGHT, DISCERNMENT & DISCRETION REGARDING HOW TO DEAL WITH THE FACTS (1:5)
  - A. God's Generosity Is Unqualified: "... Giveth To All Men Liberally"
  - B. God's Will Not Fault Us For Asking: "...And Upbraideth Not...."
  - C. God Will Give Wisdom, Not Additional Revelation: "...And It Shall Be Given Him"
