- I. A NOW ENLIGHTENED PEOPLE RECOGNIZE THE MISTAKEN ESTIMATION THEY HAD OF THE SUFFERINGS OF THE SERVANT (53:4)
 - A. They Had Estimated That God Had Judged Jesus Of Nazareth
 - 1. He Was "Stricken"
 - 2. He Was "Smitten"
 - 3. He Was "Afflicted"
 - B. Their Estimation Was Partially Correct
- II. A NOW ENLIGHTENED PEOPLE RECOGNIZE THE VICARIOUS SATISFACTION OF GOD'S JUSTICE THROUGH THE SUFFERINGS OF THE SERVANT (53:4-6)
 - A. The Contrast In The Pronouns Reveals This Particular Recognition
 - B. The Meaning Of Vicarious Suffering
 - 1. The Doctrine Of Substitution
 - 2. The Doctrine Of Atonement
 - a. Note How Many Words For Sin & Sin's Consequences Appear In This Stanza
 - b. Anyone Who By Faith, Appropriates the Confession Of This Stanza For Themselves Can Rest Assured That God Has Absolutely Not One Thing Against Him
