- A. It's Root Lies In The Hebrew Word For "Praise" (Hallel)
 - 1. The Verb (Hallel) Here Is A Plural Imperative
 - 2. The "Jah" Is The Shortened Form Of The Sacred Name Of God
- B. Compounded Together It Means "Praise Jehovah" (Praise The Lord)
 - 1. It Is Different From "Amen"
 - 2. It Occurs In Only One Chapter Of The N.T. (4 Times)

- A. The Lord's Righteous Retribution Upon False Religion (19:1-4)
 - 1. It Displays That Certain Perfections & Abilities Belong To The God Of The Bible Alone (19:1)
 - 2. It Is Entirely Moral (19:2)
 - a. Because The Great Religious Harlot Is Judged
 - b. Because The Blood Of God's Servants Is Avenged
 - 3. It Is Eternal (19:3)
 - 4. It Is Agreed Upon By Heaven's Most Exalted Inhabitants (19:4)
- B. The Lord's Anticipated Reign Is Just Around The Corner (19:5-6)
