- I. CERTAIN OPPORTUNISTIC GREEKS WERE PURSUING CHRIST HOPING TO BENEFIT FROM THE CONTACT (12:20-22)
- II. TRUE SPIRITUAL PROGRESS SPRINGS ONLY FROM SACRIFICIAL LOSS (12:23-26)
 - A. It Was Essential To Understand This Law In Order To Comprehend The Significance And Necessity Of What Christ Would Do Just A Few Days Later (12:23-24)
 - 1. It Was Necessary For Christ's Own Glorification (12:23)
 - a. He Had, At That Time Been In A State Of Humiliation
 - b. Both Testaments Taught That Suffering Would Precede Glory As Far As Messiah Was Concerned
 - 2. Christ's "Hour" Had Finally Come (12:23)
 - a. His Earthly Mother Had Previously Overlooked The Suffering Part Which Had To Precede Glorification
 - b. Just A Day Earlier, A Fever Pitched Crowd Tried To Instigate A Messianic Coronation, Ignoring The Suffering
 - 3. The Timeless Truth Is Illustrated In The Destiny Of A "Corn Of Wheat" (12:24)
 - a. Death Before Glory
 - b. Death Before Fruit
 - B. It Was Essential To Understand This Law In Order To Be Personally Benefited By What He Was Going To Do So That One Could Actually Serve The Lord After Salvation (12:25-26)
 - 1. The Paradox Is Astounding (12:25)
 - 2. Dying Daily Is The Key To Discipleship (12:26)
