- B. The Apostle Paul Addressed The Apparent Dilemma Concerning What God Would Do When A Bride (Israel) Rejects Her Spouse (Romans 9 & 11)
 - 1. Paul Uses The Word "Israel" In Two Senses: One Spiritual & One Natural (Romans 9)
 - 2. In The End, It Is The Election Of God That Guarantees That Israel Will Be Saved & Thus Available To Be A Part Of The Bride (Romans 11)
- C. The Man Or Woman Who Says: "*I Do*" To The Lord Jesus Christ, Is At That Point, "*Espoused*" To The Savior
 - 1. That Man Died To The Law In Order To Be Married To Christ
 - 2. That Man's Espousal Is Illustrated In The Lives Of Mary & Joseph
