II. THE REJECTION OF ISRAEL'S MESSIAH WAS CERTAINLY NOT A SURPRISE TO GOD SINCE HE HAD PREDICTED IT (12:38-41)

- A. John Records Two Passages Taken From The Same Prophet, Reversing The Chronological Order
 - 1. The Isaiah 53 Passage Is Comprised Of Two Questions That Imply The Kind Of Response The Lord Would Get (12:38)
 - 2. The Isaiah 6 Passage Provides A Description Of The Sequence Of The Rejection (12:40)
- B. Paul Took Comfort In The Same Prophet With Respect To The Relative Smallness of Response To His Own Ministry To The Jews
