 - 2. The Future Bodily Resurrections Of Both Believers & Unbelievers In Various Dispensations
 - 3. The Spiritual Resurrection Of Believers
- B. Explanation Of The Meaning Of "Risen, With Christ"
 - 1. Resurrection Is The Reception Of Life After Death
 - 2. Resurrection In This Sense Is Equivalent To A New Birth
