 - 1. Family Ties
 - 2. Ethnic Affinities

- C. The Lord Stresses His Choice Of Them To Encourage Them In the Face Of The Temptation To Desert Him (15:19b)

III. THE INEVITABILITY OF THE WORLD'S NEGATIVE RESPONSE (15:20)
