- I. THE APOSTLES WOULD BE SCATTERED FROM CHRIST (16:32)
 - A. The Lord Made This Prediction Because Of Their Previous Confession (16:30)
 - 1. From One Standpoint It Is A Remarkable Statement Exemplifying A Unanimous Solidarity
 - 2. Yet The Lord Asks Almost Incredulously, "Now, Do You Believe?"
 - B. The Disciples Actually Thought That The Lord Was At Last Speaking In Plain Language (16:28-30)
 - 1. A Statement On Pre Existence: I Came Forth From The Father
 - 2. A Statement On Incarnation: And Am Come Into The World
 - 3. A Statement On His Death & Resurrection: Again, I Leave The World
 - 4. A Statement On His Ascension: And Go To The Father
 - 5. A Statement On His Omniscience: Thou Knowest All Things
 - C. The Disciples' Confession Is All Based On A Faulty Understanding Of What Christ Actually Said
 - 1. As They Were Professing Knowledge They Were Betraying Ignorance
 - 2. They Changed The Lord's Verb Tenses
 - 3. The Sin Was Not So Much in The Outward Act Of Fleeing As It Was In Their Inward State Of Mind
- II. THE APOSTLES WERE GUARANTEED TO EXPERIENCE PRESSURE IN THIS LIFE (16:33)
 - A. This Pressure Is That Which Is Peculiar To A Believer And Which Rises Out Of The World's Antagonism To Christ
 - B. The Lessons For Us Are Self Evident
 - 1. Are We As Careful In Our Exegesis Of The Warning Passages Of Scripture As We Are With The Promises We Hold So Precious
 - 2. Do We Make The Professions And Confessions That We Make With Humility?
 - 3. Despite Our Immaturity And The Misunderstanding That Lies Behind The Things That We Tell The Lord We Will Do, He Has Patience And Does Not Reproach Us
