- I. THE SON PETITIONS THE FATHER TO GLORIFY HIM FOR A DISTINCTIVE PURPOSE: THE FATHER'S GLORY (17:1)
 - A. The First Person Had Previously Asked: "If I Be A Father, Where Is My Honour?"
 - B. The Second Person Was Consumed With Doing What Had Never Been Done On Earth Before Or Since
 - C. The Second Person Is Praying For Glorification For The Same Purpose For Which He Lived In Humiliation
- II. THE SON TELLS HOW HIS GLORIFICATION WOULD GLORIFY THE FATHER (17:2-3)
 - A. Christ's Petition Is In Keeping With The Authority That Had Been Given To Him To Grant Eternal Life (17:2)
 - B. Christ's Petition Is Visibly Fulfilled In A Worship Service Like This (17:3)
- III. THE SON TELLS WHY THIS WAS THE PROPER TIME FOR THE GLORIFICATION: THE COMPLETION OF HIS EARTHLY WORK (17:4)
 - A. Christ Had Faithfully Declared The Father's Words And Performed The Works That Had Been Assigned Him
 - B. Christ Had Offered Himself In Substitutionary Death
- IV. THE SON REPEATS THE ORIGINAL PETITION BUT ADDS A NEW DIMENSION TO IT (17:5)
