## "THE LORD'S PETITION FOR OUR SPIRITUAL UNITY" (PART II) JOHN 17:22-23

- I. THE FULFILLMENT OF THE LORD'S PETITION FOR UNITY IS POSSIBLE BECAUSE OF WHAT HE HIMSELF PROVIDED FOR THESE PEOPLE (17:22)
  - A. The Apostle's Initial Interpretation Of The Petition Was Probably That The Petty Tensions That Existed Between Them Due To Personal And Selfish Ambition Would Cease
  - B. The Lord Has Bestowed Glory That Makes This Unity Possible
    - 1. Facts About The Glory
      - a. It Is The Glory Which the Father First Gave To Christ
      - b. It Is The Glory Which Christ Transferred To Us
    - 2. Identification Of The Glory
      - a. It Is Not What Belonged To Christ By Virtue Of His Own Nature (cf. 17:5)
      - b. It Was Glory Indwelling A Human Body (cf. 1:14)
      - c. It Is Christ Indwelling The Believer
- II. IT IS THE SUPERNATURAL DOCTRINE OF THE MUTUALLY INDWELLING TRINITY IN THE LIFE OF BELIEVERS THAT ALLOWS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SPIRITUAL ONENESS (17:23)
  - A. This Is Far More Than People Gathering Together Under The Pretense Of A Common Religious Belief
  - B. This Is What Allows For The Contribution Of Every Member Contributing Toward The Unity Within A Body
  - C. This Is What Contributes To Evangelism
