  - A. Not the Ceremonial Offerings Associated With O.T. Law
  - B. Righteous Conduct That Inherently Involves Sacrifice
- II. GOD WOULD COUNSEL US IN THIS NEW YEAR ABOUT OUR NEED TO TRUST HIM FOR A GOOD OUTCOME (4:5b-8)
  - A. Worldly Men Never Figure This Into The Equation When It Comes To Making Hard Decisions About Life And Fellowship With God
  - B. Worldly Men Will Always Be Available To Question These Hard Decisions That Must Be Made (4:6a)
    - 1. A Lesson from Israel's History
