I. THE IDENTITY OF THESE SOULS (6:9)

- A. When Did They Die?
 - 1. Some Take The Perfect Tense Of "Were Slain" As A Reference That Must Include The Martyrs Of The Church Age
 - 2. More Likely, They Are Martyrs Who Died Within The Early Part Of The Tribulation
- B. Why Were They Slain?
 - 1. Because Of Their Personally Held Convictions
 - 2. Because Of Their Verbal Proclamations Of Those Convictions
- C. Where Were They Seen?: Under An Altar Of Sacrifice
- II. THE CRY OF THESE SOULS (6:10)
 - A. A Shocking Question That Many, Unfortunately Find Offensive
 - B. An Imprecatory Plea For Vengeance
 - 1. They Know That God Has Always Expressed An Abhorrence Of The Shedding Of People's Blood
 - 2. They Know The Divine Intention For The Tribulation, As They Are Now, In Perfect Harmony With The Will Of God

III. THE INSTRUCTION RECEIVED BY THESE SOULS (6:11)

- A. Each One Receives A Precious Possession: "White Robes"
- B. They Are Told They Must "Rest" A Little While Longer
 - 1. Until The Appointed Number Of Martyrs Is Reached
 - 2. To Fulfill Their Part In These Seal Judgments
