“A COMPARISON OF LUKE’S HISTORICAL ACCOUNT WITH THE SETTING OF ROMANS”

ACTS 19

Acts 19:21 After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the spirit, when he had passed through *Macedonia* and *Achaia*, to go to *Jerusalem*, saying, After I have been there, I must also see *Rome*.

Acts 19:22 So he sent into Macedonia two of them that ministered unto him, *Timotheus* and *Erastus*; but he himself stayed in Asia for a season. (*Where he survives the Ephesians riot!*)

Acts 20:1 And after the uproar was ceased, Paul called unto *him* the disciples, and embraced *them*, and departed for to go into *Macedonia*.

Acts 20:2 And when he had gone over those parts, and had given them much exhortation, he came into *Greece*,

Acts 20:3 And *there* abode three months...

Acts 20:4 And there accompanied him into Asia *Sopater* of Berea; and of the Thessalonians, Aristarchus and Secundus; and *Gaius* of Derbe, and *Timotheus*; and of Asia, Tychicus and Trophimus.

ROMANS 15-16

Romans 15:25 But now I go unto *Jerusalem* to minister unto the saints.

Romans 15:26 For it hath pleased them of *Macedonia* and *Achaia* to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem.

Romans 15:28 When therefore I have performed this, and have sealed to them this fruit, I will come by *you* into Spain.

Romans 16:21 *Timotheus* my workfellow, and Lucius, and Jason, and *Sosipater*, my kinsmen, salute you.

Romans 16:22 I Tertius, who wrote *this* epistle, salute you in the Lord.

Romans 16:23 *Gaius* mine host, and of the whole church, saluteth you. *Erastus* the chamberlain of the city saluteth you, and Quartus a brother.
