good word and work."

**II Thessalonians 3:3** "But the Lord is faithful, who shall *stablish* you,  
and keep you from evil."
- IV. TO BE FIXED ON THE SECOND COMING OF CHRIST**  
**James 5:8** "Be ye also patient; *stablish* your hearts: for the coming of the  
Lord draweth nigh."
