I. THREE NEGATIVE EXAMPLES OF THOSE WHO FAILED TO PERSEVERE FOR THEIR LORD (1:15)

- A. Example #1: The Majority Of The Asian Contingency That Had Been Sent To Rome
 - 1. Over A Decade Had Passed Since Paul had Established The Church At Ephesus
 - 2. The Abandonment By Those Who Had Previously Helped Paul Could Have Been A Great Discouragement To The Apostle
 - 3. Faithlessness Does Not Have To Be Part Of The Christian Life, Though God's People Do Sometimes Lapse
- B. Examples #2&3: Two Who Had Been Particularly Disappointing To Paul
 - 1. Phygellus
 - 2. Hermogenes
