I. THE SERVANT DESCRIBES THE INSTRUCTION HE RECEIVED (50:4)

- A. The Instructor Was No One Less Than The First Person Of The Trinity
- B. The Purpose Of The Servant's Instruction Was To Speak The Right Thing At Just The Right Time
- C. The Methodology Was Two Fold
 - 1. With Respect To Time: The Servant Was Awakened *Morning By Morning*
 - 2. With Respect To Inner Receptivity: The Servant Was Given The Ability To Receive Revelation From Heaven
