

ISRAEL CONFESSES THE SERVANT'S VICARIOUS ATONEMENT (PART II) ISAIAH 53:4-6

I. ISRAEL'S HISTORIC ADMISSION (53:4)

- A. Matthew Records The Actual Fulfillment Of The Prophecy That Messiah Would Bear The Nations Grievs And Carry Her Sorrows (Matthew 8:16-17)
 - 1. In The Very First Servant Song It Was Revealed That Messiah Would Come To Set Judgment In The Earth (42:4)
 - 2. As The Lord Went About His Earthly Ministry, Working Miracles, He Was Reversing The Effects Of The Fall
- B. Though Israel Could Not Deny The Reality Of The Lord's Actions, Still They Esteemed Him To Be An Unusual Object Of Divine Displeasure
 - 1. He Was Not The Messiah They Had Hoped For
 - 2. Nothing Has Changed

II. ISRAEL'S DESCRIPTION OF THE SUFFERINGS MESSIAH ENDURED WHICH RIGHTLY BELONGED TO THEM (53:5-6)

- A. The Description Of Terms Broken Down (53:5)
 - 1. *Wounded*: A Violent Piercing (Impaling)
 - 2. *Bruised*: Pressed To the Point Of Crushing
 - 3. *Chastisement*: Receiving The Just Due For Previous Offenses (Punishment)
 - 4. *Stripes*: The Raising Of Welts From The Surface of The Skin
- B. The Reasons For This Kind Of Suffering (53:5)
 - 1. *Our Transgressions* (Rebellion)
 - 2. *Our Iniquities* (Distorted, Twisted Perversions)
 - 3. To Procure *Our Peace* (Well Being)
 - 4. To Insure *We Are Ultimately Healed*
- C. The Extent Of The Efficacy Of This Vicarious Atonement (53:6)
 - 1. *All We...Us All*
 - 2. The Measure of The Atonement Matches the Measure Of The Alienation
