

# LAST CONCERNS

## JOHN 13:31-33

- I. SEVEN APOSTOLIC INTERRUPTIONS THROUGHOUT THE DISCOURSE HIGHLIGHT THE FACT THAT THE DISCIPLES DID NOT UNDERSTAND THE REALITY OF CHRIST'S "GOING" AND THEIR "STAYING"**
- II. THE LORD PROVIDED AN INTERPRETATION OF THE EVENTS THAT WOULD SOON TAKE PLACE (13:31-32)**
  - A. The Crux Of The Interpretation Is Summarized In One Word:  
*Glorification*
    - 1. The *Glory* Of Anything Is Its Unique Excellence
    - 2. The Successive Train Of Events, Set In Motion By The Expulsion Of Judas, Was Determined By God To Be A  
*Glorification*
  - B. The Overlying Presupposition Is The Mutual Indwelling Of The Father And The Son
    - 1. The Father Glorifies Himself In The Son
    - 2. The Son Is Glorified In The Father
- III. THE LORD INTRODUCED THE NEARNESS OF THE SEPARATION THAT WAS ABOUT TO OCCUR (13:31)**
  - A. He Saves His Tenderest Address For These Who Had Received Him
  - B. Not One Of Those Men On That Side Of The Cross, Knew What Most Of Us Know Today
