

“THESE AND OTHER THINGS JESUS DID”

JOHN 21:24-25

I. THE HUMAN AUTHOR’S TESTIMONY TO EVERY WORD AND EVERY EVENT CONTAINED PREVIOUSLY IN THIS GOSPEL IS THAT IT IS ALL TRUE (21:24)

A. The Human Author [*The Disciple*] Is Never Directly Named Anywhere In this Gospel

1. The Testimony Of The Church Father, Irenaeus & Others

2. The Holy Spirit Ministered To John’s Heart, Five Times That He Was [*The Disciple Whom Jesus Loved*]

B. The Human Author Testified That He Was Still Alive As The Autograph Was Being Distributed And Perhaps Even Copied

C. The Human Author Included, At Least The Believers At Ephesus With His [*We*], In Affirming The Position Of Many, That From Beginning To End, This Account Is [*True*]

1. All The Metaphors Used To Describe The Lord Jesus Christ

2. All The Things The Lord Jesus Christ Said

3. All The Things The Lord Jesus Christ Did

II. THE HUMAN AUTHOR TESTIFIED THAT AN ENCYCLOPEDIA RECORD OF THE THINGS JESUS DID WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE (21:25)

A. It Does Take A Lot Of Paper & Ink To Record The Exploits Of Great People

B. It Is Not Hyperbole When John Writes That The Entire World Could Not Contain The Books It Would Take To Record Everything There Was To Say About Jesus
