- I. THE HUMAN AUTHOR'S TESTIMONY TO EVERY WORD AND EVERY EVENT CONTAINED PREVIOUSLY IN THIS GOSPEL IS THAT IT IS ALL TRUE (21:24)
 - A. The Human Author [The Disciple] Is Never Directly Named Anywhere In this Gospel
 - 1. The Testimony Of The Church Father, Irenaeus & Others
 - 2. The Holy Spirit Ministered To John's Heart, Five Times That He Was [The Disciple Whom Jesus Loved]
 - B. The Human Author Testified That He Was Still Alive As The Autograph Was Being Distributed And Perhaps Even Copied
 - C. The Human Author Included, At Least The Believers At Ephesus With His [We], In Affirming The Position Of Many, That From Beginning To End, This Account Is [True]
 - 1. All The Metaphors Used To Describe The Lord Jesus Christ
 - 2. All The Things The Lord Jesus Christ Said
 - 3. All The Things The Lord Jesus Christ Did
- II. THE HUMAN AUTHOR TESTIFIED THAT AN ENCYCLOPEDIC RECORD OF THE THINGS JESUS DID WOULD BE IMPOSSIBLE (21:25)
 - A. It Does Take A Lot Of Paper & Ink To Record The Exploits Of Great People
 - B. It Is Not Hyperbole When John Writes That The Entire World Could Not Contain The Books It Would Take To Record Everything There Was To Say About Jesus
