REVELATION 15:1-8

I. JOHN DESCRIBES THE INITIAL GLIMPSE HE IS GIVEN OF THE SIGN OF THESE SEVEN ANGELS AS SOMETHING *GREAT & MARVELLOUS* (15:1)

A. Rarely Does Anyone Ever See A Revelation Of The Wrath Of God As Something *Great & Marvelous*

B. The Plagues & The Plan Behind Them Reveal The Importance Of This Sign

II. JOHN DESCRIBES A VAST THRONG OF VICTORIOUS PEOPLE IN HEAVEN (15:2-4)

A. They Are Victorious Because Of Their Complete & Utter Rejection Of The Antichrist & Everything That Pertained To Him (15:2)

1. They Are All Martyrs

2. Though Consumed On Earth They Stand Immortal In The Presence Of God

B. They Sing The Song Of Moses And Of The Lamb (15:3-4)

1. Of The Two Songs Associated With Moses In His Lifetime, The One Most Parallel To This Context Is Exodus 15:1-19

2. It Is Called The Song Of The Lamb Because He Has Secured The Final Victory For His People According To Rev. 5

3. Reasons Are Given To *Fear* Him (15:4)

a. They Sing Of Christ’s Ultimate Incomparability

b. They Sing Of The Universality Of Christ’s Worship

c. They Sing Of The Rightness Of Christ’s Judgments

III. JOHN DESCRIBES THE ARMING OF THESE ANGELS WITH THEIR WEAPONRY (15:5-8)

A. Seven Great Angelic Figures Emerge From The Temple, Not Dressed In Black, But In White & Gold (15:5-6)

B. As Each Angel Receives His Vial The Temple Fills With Smoke(15:7-8)
