 - A. **This Desire To Withdraw From Such Manifests Itself In An Imprecatory Statement (139:19a)**
 - B. **This Desire To Withdraw From Such Manifests Itself In A Plea For Departure (139:19b)**

- II. **DAVID PROVIDES SOME REASONS WHY HE CANNOT TOLERATE THE EVIL OF GOD HATERS (139:20-22)**
 - A. **What Comes Out Of Their Mouth (139:20)**
 - B. **What Is Embedded In Their Heart & Thus Proceeds Out In Negative Activity (139:21)**
 - C. **What They Actually Are To Him (139:22)**

- III. **DAVID ONCE AGAIN INVITES GOD TO SEARCH & TEST HIM AS ONLY GOD CAN (139:23-24)**
 - A. **In Light Of The First Three Stanzas Any Anxious Thought About God On David's Part Would Be A Contradiction To All Those Truths About God (139:23)**
 - B. **The Psalm Ends With A Petition For God To Reveal To David Anything In David's Life That Might Cause God Pain (139: 24)**
