ROMANS 2:1-5

I. GOD LEVELS A STINGING INDICTMENT ON EXCUSELESS HUMAN JUDGES (2:1)

- A. Because (At Least In The Case Of The Jew) They Are Enlightened Beyond The Level Of The Majority Of The World.
- B. Because They Condemn Themselves In Their Hypocrisy.
- C. Because Of Their Obsession With The External.

II. THE EXCUSELESS HUMAN JUDGE WILL NOT ESCAPE THE JUDGMENT OF GOD (2:2-5)

A. Who Judges According To Truth (2:2-4)

- 1. Contrary To The Presumptuous Calculations Of Man's Hypocritical Thinking (2:3)
- 2. Contrary To The Privilege Man Knows He Is Enjoying (2:4-5)
 - a. Some Lost People Experience A Wealth Of God's Goodness And Longsuffering (2:4a)
 - b. Most Lost People Ignore The Intent Of God's Goodness (2:4b)

B. Who Will Tap Into The Treasury Man Stores Up For Himself (2:5)

- 1. Man Stores Actively: Because Of A Hard Heart
- 2. Man Stores Passively: Because Of An Impenitent Heart
