I. THE FIRST QUESTION AND ANSWER (3:1-2)

A. Question: “What Real Advantage Does The Jew (Religious Man) Have?” (3:1)

B. Answer: “They (He) Were Entrusted With The Very Utterances Of God” (3:2)

II. THE SECOND QUESTION AND ANSWER (3:3-4)

A. Question: “Unbelief Does Not Nullify God’s Faithfulness, Does It? (“If God Is A God Of Love, Isn’t He Obligated To Act Positively On My Behalf?”) (3:3)

B. Answer: “Reject Monstrous Conclusions About God And Square Up With What Scripture Says About Him.” (3:4)

III. THE THIRD QUESTION AND ANSWER (3:5-8)

A. Question: “Since Man’s Sin Magnifies God’s Righteousness, How Can He Be Just (Fair) In Judging Us?” (Aren’t We Making Him Look Good?) (3:5)

B. Answer: “If God Were Really Unjust He Could Not Legitimately Judge The World. Since This Is Impossible, You Can Count On The Fact That You Will Be Judged For God Is Apriori Just” (3:6-8)
